

MOUNT GAMBIER NETBALL ASSOCIATION UMPIRE BYLAWS

1. **REGISTRATION:** All umpires must be registered. The fee of \$8.00 per umpire or \$20.00 per team must be paid to the Treasurer. After the third round of matches a club shall not replace a registered umpire without paying a new registration fee. Failure to register an umpire will incur a \$10 fine per offence.
2. **CLUB UMPIRING REQUIRMENTS:** Clubs are to provide one permanent or two umpires per team. Clubs are allowed two reserve umpires per team. Clubs with junior teams are allowed one additional reserve umpire. (Clubs can supply a team for rotation throughout the season for one umpire duty. I.e. a club nominating a team in B Grade can use those players for rotation as their nominated umpire.
3. **STANDARD:** All club umpires must be of an appropriate standard, i.e. if a B grade team is nominated, then an umpire capable and willing to umpire B grade must also be nominated. All 11&U B teams nominated must have an experienced umpire nominate for them.
4. **NOTICE OF ALTERATION:** Clubs are to give the MGNA umpire co-coordinator one week's notice in writing if player umpires alter grades and/or teams.
5. **FINE/FORFEITURE:**
 - a) If an umpire fails to check in at the umpire's desk, and the umpiring duty cannot be covered by a reserve, then the most senior team of the club in question will be responsible for covering the duty. Failure to cover the duty will result in the most senior team of the club involved which is playing at the timeslot in question being required to forfeit their game and one of the players must then cover the umpiring duty. In the event of there being two or more teams, in the same grade, all teams will be required to forfeit if an umpire is not found.
 - b) A fine of \$20 per club will apply if an umpire fails to umpire when rostered or fails to supply a registered umpire to take their place. Clubs are not permitted to use reserves listed in the roster.
 - c) A fine of \$15 will apply if an umpire listed as a reserve in the roster fails to check in prior to the stated match time and the reserve umpire is to remain for the duration of that timeslot.
 - d) A personal fine of \$50 will apply if an umpire rostered for finals fails to supply a replacement umpire of sufficient standard.

Reserve umpires are to receive half normal match payments if they are not required to umpire.

To be entitled to full match payments The Rules of Netball Theory must be up to date (i.e. sat and passed every five years).

Any umpire signing in for a scheduled match, which has been forfeited on the day, is entitled to receive full match payments even if they do not umpire.

To be entitled to full match payments umpires are required to attend 3 clinics comprising any or all of the following but must include one of three set clinics (dates to be advised).

Umpire at the following

- Squad Selection Trainings
- Local Carnival (e.g. Mount Gambier or Portland)
- Knockout Netball
- SAPSASSA Tryouts (counts as one clinic)
- In Adelaide with Squad – June long weekend (counts as 2 clinics)
- Schools

Any umpire sitting on an Umpire Panel will have it recognised as one clinic

PS You must notify the Umpire Co-ordinator of your participation in the above.

All badged umpires will receive \$50 per finals match regardless of clinic attendance. All other umpires will receive \$20 per finals match regardless of clinic attendance.
Reserve badged umpires will receive \$20. Reserve unbadged umpires will receive \$10.
